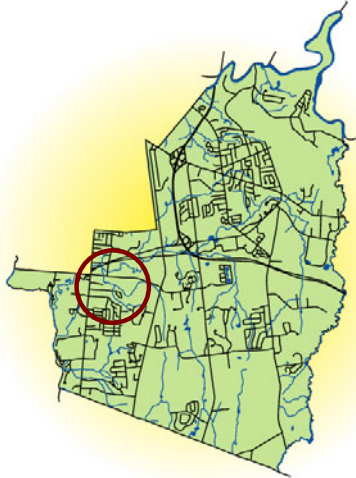

Farrell Park Constructed Wetland

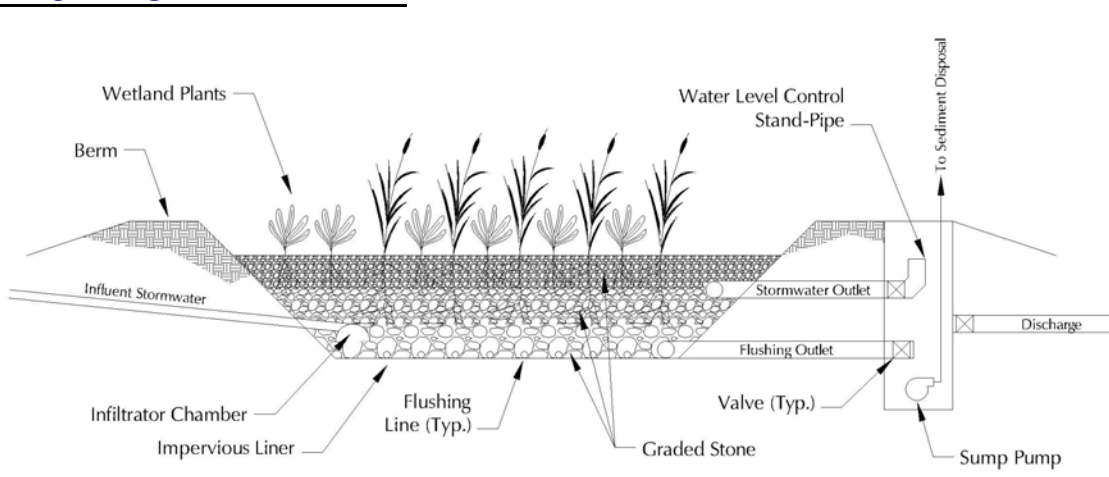


Schematic of stormwater treatment wetland

Project Description:	Construction of a gravel stormwater treatment wetland to collect and treat stormwater runoff from the Farrell Park parking area. The gravel parking lot is 0.75 acres and runoff previously flowed untreated into Potash Brook.
Benefit:	The project will reduce the amount of sediment and nutrients (e.g. phosphorus and nitrogen) flowing to Potash Brook.
Funding Sources:	Stormwater Utility Funds, EPA Grant
Dates/Timeline:	2008
Total Project Value:	\$21,500
Best Management Practices:	Gravel stormwater treatment wetland
